# Share Your Research

All abstracts concerning development and use of PROMIS tools will be considered for oral or poster presentation. Please consider submitting an abstract in relation to the specific PROMIS topics:

1. Design and implementation of PROs initiatives and programs
2. Clinical transformation using PROs
3. Population health initiatives using PROs
4. Psychometrics: advances in and applications of PROs
5. Incorporation of PROs into digital health initiatives
6. Policy and health care delivery system transformation efforts using PROs

## **Awards for Best Posters by Trainees**

Eligible persons are students, medical trainees, post-doctoral fellows, and early career professionals within 5 years of completing their final degree and are the first author on the abstract.

### **There will be 2 awards:**

Best Psychometric  
PROMIS Poster by a Trainee  
and  
Best Application of  
PROMIS Poster by a Trainee

## **Abstract Instructions**

Individuals may serve as an author on multiple abstracts, however, an individual may submit no more than three abstracts and present no more than two abstracts. The submitting author will be notified of the decision and presentation format (oral or poster) via email by June 30, 2026. All accepted abstracts will be distributed to conference participants in pdf format in the conference program book. Unless otherwise specified, the first author will be considered as the presenting author. All presenters and attendees must register for the conference. Please note: Students, trainees, post-doctoral fellows, and early-career professionals applying for a conference scholarship must submit an abstract to be considered for a scholarship award.

## **Directions for Abstract Submission**

The word limit for the abstract body is 350 words (excluding title, authors, and affiliations).

Each abstract must include the following information:

**Title:** Capitalize the first letter of the first word and use other lower-case letters in the title, except for proper words such as PROMIS (15 WORD LIMIT).

**Type of Presentation:** Indicate oral, poster, or either presentation.

**Authors:** List full name of each author.

**Institutional Affiliations:** List the primary institutional affiliation for each author.

**Body:** Use separate paragraphs for each section – Objective, Methods, Results, Conclusions.

**Content:** Author(s) must attest that the submission is an original work.

If AI-assisted technologies are used to draft and improve the readability of the abstract, author(s) must attest to this use. Author(s) are fully responsible for the content of the abstract.

**Do not include figures and tables. 350 Word Limit.**
